## Norm Blye

Norm Blye, one of the original homeowners in Victoria Park, died May 22 after a period of illness. Norm was born in Bellevue in 1918, he attended Garfield High School, and he married Esther Carlson in 1943. Norm and Esther bought their Victoria Park home in 1975 and they lived in that home for the remainder of his life.

Norm was a past Vice-President of the Victoria Park Homeowners' Association (VPHA), he was a past chairman of the VPHA Architectural Control Committee, and he served two three-year terms on the VPHA Board of Trustees. In January 2005 Norm was the guest speaker at the annual VPHA open meeting when he presented "Ferry Tales of Lake Washington" that told of many interesting and humorous histories of the Washington State Ferries.

Norm and Esther were always in attendance at the VPHA annual meetings and summer picnics. Norm was one of the finest residents of our community, and he will be sadly missed.
