Victoria Park Receives Art Grant

Our Children's Park is a hidden gem in Victoria Park. Last year, a group of parents came up with an idea to create a mosaic in the park. A grant proposal was written, applied for through the City of Renton's Neighborhood Grant Program, and it was approved!

The Victoria Park Homeowners Association has been awarded a grant for \$700 to create a one-of-a-kind community-based art project in our park.

We want you to be a part of this project too!

The idea is to create a mosaic around the bench facing the swing set. In it, we plan to embed colorful marbles, tiles, rocks, and tiny trinkets. We are asking every person who lives in Victoria Park to contribute one item to this project. Items should be no larger than two inches across and non-biodegradeable. Examples are: A rock from your front lawn, a marble, a plastic or metal toy, a broken tile or dish, and other small, solid trinkets. Please note your item will not be returned, but instead it will be embedded in cement, on display forever in the Children's
